Title: NEC Inspector

Basic Responsibilities: Provide independent inspection services through National Electrical Code (NEC) inspectors. Inspect and certify new and/or modifications of electrical systems, equipment, and components.

Organizational Relationship: Reports to the QA Manager/Director of Projects.

Essential Functions: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- May be given drawings for review, prior to performing inspection.
- Travel to designated locations, to perform an NEC field inspection in accordance with applicable Hanford Site standards and procedures.
- Prepare and sign off on NEC permit documents as needed.
- Work to meet or exceed QA standards.
- All other duties assigned by Manager.

Skill, Knowledge, Education and Experience:

- Complete required training to access Hanford TOC facilities as needed.
- Maintain International Association of Electrical Inspectors (IAEI) general electrical inspector certification.
- Have at least four (4) years of experience as a journeyman electrician.
- Maintain NFPA-70E standards for electrical safety training credentials.
- Authorized Hanford worker lock and tag trained.

Work Environment:

This position operates in a professional office environment and involves routine travel for site inspections.
